Since 1964 the EFC has facilitated strategic conversations and initiatives among denominational and faith leaders. The EFC provides a national forum and a compassionate voice for biblical principles in life and society and distinctly Canadian research on church and faith trends.

The EFC interacts regularly in the Courts and on Parliament Hill on the most pressing issues of the day, such as religious freedom and protection of the vulnerable.

*Faith Today*, Canada's Christian magazine is published by the EFC, providing excellent Christian journalism to our country, and telling the stories of what God is doing through His Church in Canada.

The EFC is made up of:

- charitable ministry organizations doing humanitarian, evangelistic, and community service
- postsecondary Christian universities, colleges, seminaries and graduate schools
- hundreds of individual church congregations that span traditions.

## We engage with public policy and legal issues

With our Ottawa office near Parliament and the Supreme Court, the EFC offers trusted monitoring, research, and analysis to help Evangelicals think through and respond to the social, legislative, and legal issues of the day. The EFC encourages dialogue among church and interfaith leaders on the application of biblical principles through study guides, background and position papers, fact sheets, government submissions and legal interventions all the way to the Supreme Court.

The EFC provides an operational platform – a gathering place – for networks and partnerships from a variety of ministry sectors such as Global Mission, Bible Engagement, Indigenous Ministry, Christian Higher Education and Youth and Young Adults. The EFC has been an incubator for many networks that have gone on to serve the Canadian Church.

## We do cutting-edge research for and about Canadian Evangelicals

Understanding Canadian church and faith trends helps us better explain who we are as Evangelicals, understand our place in the broader culture, and make better ministry decisions. The EFC works collaboratively to conduct and foster research that studies the changing contexts in churches and Canadian society.

Expert teams within the EFC produce a variety of resources that help improve how Evangelicals minister and serve in Canada. EFC podcasts, webinars and booklets on topics like religious freedom, pornography and euthanasia and palliative care equip us all to interact well with the issues of the day. We also publish the award winning bi-monthly magazines *Faith Today*, and *Love is Moving*, a youth and youth leader set of printed and digital resources.
