Sample phone conversation for concerned citizens

It takes less than 5 minutes to call your MLA:

“Hi, my name is [first name, last name]. I live in [name of riding/town/city]. I support conscience protection for health care professionals, and I'd like my MLA to support Bill 207. It is possible to protect both patient care and freedom of conscience and religion, and I think the government should treat both as a matter of priority and importance.”

I'm asking you to support Bill 207. This bill would ensure there is strong protection for Albertan health care professionals with deeply held beliefs. It is both possible and essential to protect both patient care and freedom of conscience and religion.
