Sample letter for concerned citizens

Dear [MP or Senator's name],

Thank you for serving our riding. I appreciate the hard work you do for our community.

I am very concerned about Bill C-6. I don't support conversion therapy or any forced or abusive practices.

But this bill seems like it will do far more than that. The definition includes "a practice ...designed to ...reduce ... sexual behaviour."

I'm concerned this bill will make it a criminal offence to share religious beliefs on sexuality. It may affect the ability to teach our kids in our homes. It could even limit how doctors can treat their patients.

Please change Bill C-6 to make it clear that it will not have this effect. Make the definition clearer and more specific. Add exceptions that clearly protect religious faith and practice, family conversations and medical treatment.

Without these changes, Bill C-6 poses a serious threat to our rights and freedoms.
